- We only live one kilometre away from school, but my host father picks us up every day. This is typical of Australia: Nobody goes by bike or walks and I already miss my bike. I'm
- 20 afraid to lose my fitness and to get fat because we eat so much fast food here. Now I have got to go. It is time for dinner again. Hope to hear from you soon.

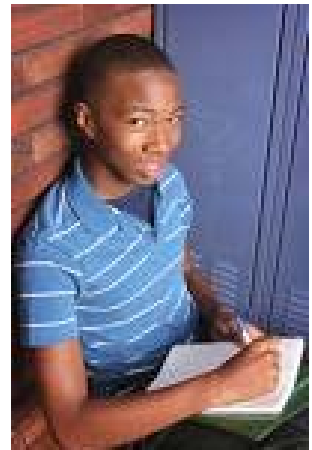

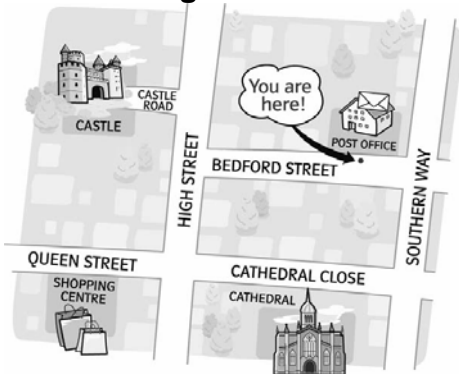
